## Last Man Standing - Rules!

- Every round you pick a team from the Premier League or Championship which you think will **win**.
- If they **win**, you are into the next round. If they **draw** or **lose** then you are knocked out!
- You can only pick a team once throughout the competition. So, if you pick Liverpool one week and they win, you cannot pick them again!
- Games included are those played between Friday and Monday.
- Team selection deadline is Thursday 10pm each week for the duration of the competition. A spreadsheet will be pinned to the notice board at BTSC for entries or they can be made by texting;

- It is **your** job to check to make sure you have not picked the same team twice. If a team is picked for a second time and it goes unnoticed until the deadline has passed you will be knocked out.
- Team selections cannot be amended after the deadline date, if you have **not** submitted a team then you will be knocked out.
- The competition will run each week until there is a winner, if you are the **Last Man Standing** you will win the prize pot.
- In the event of having no winner, 2 people left and they both lose, the money will rollover into a whole new round. The competition starts again, and it will be a double prize pot.
